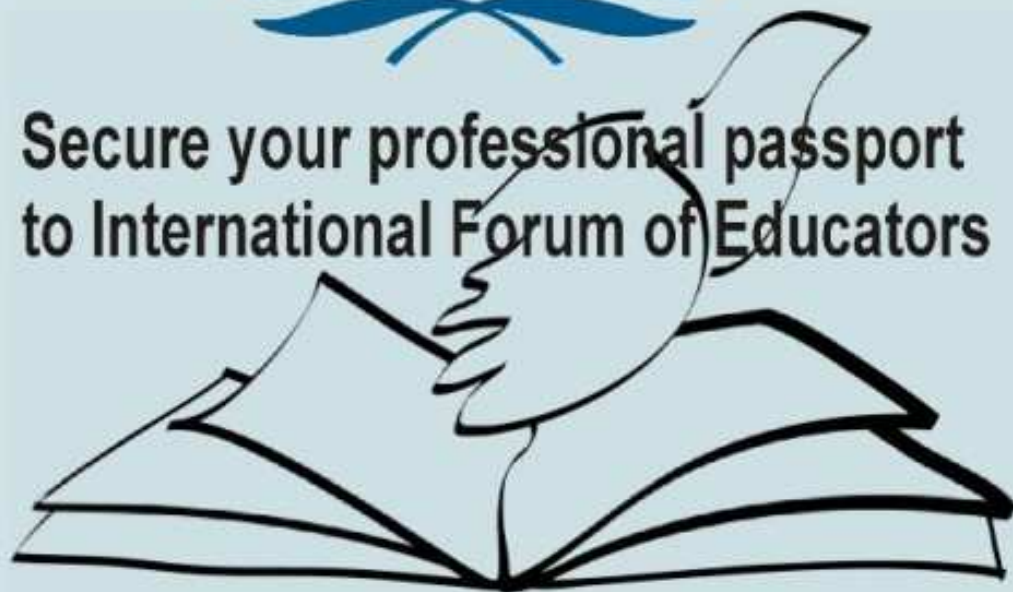

The Academic Council of CCLP Worldwide is established as an International Organization of Education Charter by CCLP Worldwide.

It is having special Consultative Status with UN ECOSOC, Institutional Membership of UNESCO NEQMAP and UN Academic Impact.

It is specially accredited from United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development (Rio+20)





The Fellow Chartered Educator, an academic rank and title aims to recognize the outstanding contribution of Educational initiative and research of early to mid-career academics to Higher Education Institutions.

It also aims to support their research and to build stronger ties between Academicians, professors and Educators worldwide

The Fellow Chartered Educators are champions of promoting the cause of Education Charter.

"The International Education Charter is a declaration of fundamental principles guiding youth education worldwide in the 21st century. Created by global civil society, CCLP Worldwide and endorsed by thousands of members, volunteers, organizations, institutions and individuals engaged in promoting the position of youth, the International Education Charter is not only a call to action, but a motivating force inspiring change the world over. The International Education Charter is being implemented into the Declaration of Higher Education for the 21st century by UNESCO, and Ten Principles of United Nations Global Compact for the purposes of creating and a more purposeful and sustainable future for today's youth."



## Selection of Fellow

The Academic Council of CCLP Worldwide has laid down criteria to select and approve the application.

Post Graduate Degree in any stream or discipline (Preferably doctoral qualification or Masters Degree. The postgraduate professionals like Chartered Accountants, Chartered Analysts, holder of Post Graduate Diploma in Business Administration, Company Secretaries Cost Accountant, Stock analysts etc. are also eligible).

A sufficient involvement in any subject through training, professional work, research, publications or other work of a similar nature (A letter from Concern, publication House, Research Unit, Academy, College or any other department may be accepted as basis of such involvement.)

The candidate must be proposed by existing Fellow of the Academic Council or by any academic Institution, NGO, Government Department or Elected Representative. The submission of Research paper or book or any publication authored by candidate may be additional requirement but not mandatory.

Payment of requisite fees (In case of rejection the entire fees will be reufunded).

## Privileges of Fellow

Selection of Fellow is professional recognition in his or her respective field.

Fellows are entitled to use the title Fellow Chartered Educator in full or FCE in short at the end of their name

Fellows are preferred to submit their research papers/ analysis in the publication of CCLP Worldwide.

Fellowship is an addition to academic qualification.

Fellows are entitled to use the facilities of Members of CCLP Worldwide except voting rights. Fellows are encouraged to explore the online resources of CCLP Worldwide site at <http://cclpworldwide.com/esi>

Fellows are encouraged to nominate candidate for fellowship (Not more than 2 per year).

Fellows are invited to attend range of conferences, seminars and events of CCLP Worldwide and its affiliated institutions.
